A unique community partnership has been formed to address a critical need within the larger Holmen community. Thanks to the incredible generosity of Dave and Barb Skogen, the Holmen community has the opportunity to establish a Boys and Girls Club and community center within the former Festival Building on Holmen Drive.

Centrally located with adjacent parking, this facility will include space for Boys and Girls Club programs, space for more senior members of the area, spaces for the School District of Holmen and community use, including two gymnasiums and a playground. Making these collaborations happen requires dollars to assist with renovations and program developments.

The need is real.

The northern La Crosse County Corridor is the second fastest population growth area in the state. A safe and welcoming space for the residents of the area is vital.

- **For youth** – According to La Crosse County, the most dangerous time for youth is between 3 and 7 p.m. Even though Holmen is the largest school in the Mississippi Conference, it's the only one that does not have a dedicated space for after-school activities and learning support, putting many kids at risk.
- **For retirees** – Similarly, people of retirement age do not have a center for socialization, medical and nutrition support, and many other needs.

The momentum is building.

The greater Holmen community has already committed significant support for this project, providing funds, in-kind donations and volunteerism. This is an exciting time to be a part of the community!
